Key Stage Four Curriculum (updated September 2017)

The Key Stage Four programme is reviewed and adapted each year. In Years 10 and 11 students study PSHE (including RE) as well as PE. There are 29 lessons in a week. The numbers of lessons per subject are shown below. Most students follow the same core subjects.
