In Years 7-9 all students study the same broad range of subjects. The table below shows how many lessons are given to each subject per week. There are 29 lessons in a school week.

Explanatory Notes

- In Years 7 and 8, students have a Library lesson to develop and track their reading. They also follow a Literacy curriculum in this Library lesson.
- For Dance and Drama, students rotate from one discipline to the other.
- For Modern Languages students do either: French, German or Spanish. All students learn one language from entry.
- In Design Technology, students rotate across the following disciplines: Food, Graphics, Product Design, Resistant Materials, Textiles
- PSHE is Personal, Social, Health, Careers and Economic Education
