Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of your child's GCSE, BTEC or NCFE qualification, it is required that they complete a Non-Examined Assessment (NEA). This is a compulsory component that their subject teacher will have prepared them for as part of their course. The NEA marks contribute towards the overall final grade received in the summer of Year 11.

When students have completed their NEA, subject teachers will follow a robust moderation procedure to ensure the accuracy and consistency of marking. Once this has been completed, NEA marks will be shared with students by their class teacher in school by the following dates:
