



Summer School Provision 2021

During 2021, the Department for Education provided funding for secondary schools to run summer provision with a particular focus on students transferring into Year 7. The Earls High School delivered a successful 5 day summer school, attended by 97 pupils from our feeder primary schools and run by volunteers from our fantastic teaching and support staff.

Purpose:

- A week long summer school offering a blend of academic education and enrichment activities.
- To prepare children for the transition to secondary school.

Expected Outcomes:

- Close reading and mathematics gaps
- Reduce the attainment gap
- Support mental Wellbeing
- Help a smooth transition into secondary school

Children joining The Earls High School in September 2021 and in particular.

- Disadvantaged children
- Children on the SEND register
- Children who have been adversely affected by the COVID pandemic.
- Children who may be the only one joining Earls from their Primary School
