

Things to do over the Christmas holidays to make you feel festive

Whether you want to get out the house or simply want to feel in the Christmas spirit, here's five things we think you can do over the holidays:



Enchanted Gardens: Visit Webb's in Hagley for a wander around a picturesque Christmas village complete with fairy lights and lanterns. It is ideal for a family experience as children and adults alike will enjoy the beautiful views. Events start from the 6th of November and go on through to January, with tickets averaging at around £8.50.

Walking with the Snowman Trail, Birmingham: Partake on an amazing adventure around Birmingham to find 12 sculptures inspired from The Snowman, a Christmas classic. It is ideal if you want to explore more of Birmingham as it takes you around iconic parts of the city. These wonderful statues stay until 6th January 2022, so get hunting! This event is free.



Ice Rink Birmingham: Skate your way into December at the ice-skating rink in Century Square, Birmingham. This large ice skating rink is covered, so no matter the weather, you can skate! It is also located near the Birmingham Big Wheel, which makes for some great scenery whilst you're skating. Tickets are £9.50 per person over 12, and you can add concessions, penguins, and a trip on the Big Wheel for extra! This event goes until 9th January, 2022.

[Jewellery Quarter Christmas Window Trail](#): Explore the magic of the Jewellery Quarter with over 75 wonderfully crafted window displays along a trail which exhibits some of the Jewellery Quarter's defining features, along with independent attractions

supporting the trail. The trail also includes two 30-foot Christmas trees! With it only being a 15 minute walk from Birmingham City Centre, it is very accessible. The trail itself is free, however the attractions can be both paid and unpaid. The event runs until 25th December 2021.



[Christmas Village & Grotto](#): Visit an amazing Christmas village and grotto with mystery and surprises around every corner, complete with festive decor all around and a chance to meet Father Christmas for younger siblings! It is located in West Hagley.

Tickets are £8.50 for children, as they receive their very own real Christmas tree, and £2.50 for accompanying adults. The event runs until the 24th December.
